Dear Friends,

We are happy to share our first Newsletter with you.

What impact does an Anouk project have?

After having their walls and ceilings painted by the Anouk-Artists, the Hospital Civico in Lugano organised a survey over 5 months to study the impact of the project on their patients and staff. A total of 100 people were interviewed, 75 patients and their families and 25 staff members. Their findings include:

- 79% of children and young adults confirm: paintings reduce their fear of hospitals.
- 80% of children and young adults say: paintings encourage them to day-dream.
- 89% of parents attest: paintings help their children during treatments.
- 91% of parents state: paintings improve communication with their children.
- 100% of parents and medical staff report: the hospital seems more welcoming and has a friendlier atmosphere.
- 96% of medical staff verify: paintings help them interact with young patients and distract them during treatments.



<u>Case study</u>: project at the Children's Hospital La Charité in Berlin

This summer a team of five Anouk-trained-artists painted murals in the Intensive Care ward.

The head doctor explained that the atmosphere in the ward has become calmer and friendlier. People coming into the closed ward, are immediately soothed by the new environment.

A nurse reported: a little girl didn't want to leave her room, because she liked the murals so much!

My work: anecdote from one of our artists

In Garches-Paris at the Hospital Raymond Poincaré a 10 year old boy undergoing cancer treatment discovers an Anouk-Artist in his room.

"How do you like this drawing? Is there anything missing? Which colours would you prefer?"

Contact is established, we start to speak about the drawing and time flies by before his next chemotherapy. His parents tell me that he was never so calm before a treatment. Upon his return, I'm still in his room; he smiles at me and falls asleep.

The next morning I find him on his bed, sketching the mural. He is no longer preoccupied by the illness, but wants to draw and dream.
